The new European framework for electronic communications, the European Electronic Communications Code (EECC), extends the role of the RSPG in the European Union in the field of spectrum. At the stakeholder workshop in Berlin, we would like to give you an insight into the ongoing work of the RSPG working groups, in particular in the light of the new EECC.

As part of the workshop, we would like to exchange initial ideas with all participants regarding the next work programme and receive their input with regard to possible work items to be covered in the years 2020/2021.
