**Subject: Chairman's Report of the Extraordinary RSPG Plenary meeting on 04 December 2020**

## MEETING REPORT

The extraordinary Plenary meeting was called by the RSPG Chair Frank Krüger (Germany) in order to facilitate an input from the RSPG to the Special Group set up by the Commission Recommendation of 18 September 2020 *on a common Union toolbox for reducing the cost of deploying very high capacity networks and ensuring timely and investment-friendly access to 5G radio spectrum, to foster connectivity in support of economic recovery from the COVID-19 crisis in the Union.*<sup>1</sup>

The meeting took place “on-line” given the restrictions in force as a result of the covid-19 pandemic. The European Commission was represented by Vesa Terava, Acting Director for Electronic Communications Networks and Services, DG CONNECT.

The RSPG subsequently adopted an input to the Special Group (RSPG20-39).

On behalf of the Group the RSPG Chair thanked the co-chairs of the RSPG Sub Groups dealing with Additional Spectrum needs, Peer review and awards and spectrum sharing for their efforts in facilitating the process.

The next meeting of the RSPG will take place on 10 February 2021.
